# COVID-19 News to Know

- ◆ Due to the Thanksgiving holiday, some COVID-19 community testing sites may be closed. Be sure to call ahead or visit [testupmke.com](https://testupmke.com) for the most updated information. You can also call 211 for information.
- ◆ The average number of new daily cases over the last seven days was 5,732, which is being reported by the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel as a possible early indicator of a high plateau in the number of cases.
- ◆ Wisconsin Department of Health Services is asking individuals who test positive for COVID-19 to tell family and friends to keep them safe. Contact tracers are currently unable to manage the volume of new cases.
- ◆ American Indians continue to have the highest number of confirmed cases per 100,000 residents when compared with other races. The current seven-day moving average of daily confirmed cases per 100,000 American Indian residents is 190. Averages for other races are: White-96, Black-108, Asian-51, Other Races-63.
- ◆ 1,999 individuals in Wisconsin are currently hospitalized with COVID-19.
- ◆ 438 individuals are currently in hospital Intensive Care Units in Wisconsin.
- ◆ Governor encourages Wisconsinites to take care of their mental health this season. Help is available at [resilient.wisconsin.gov](https://resilient.wisconsin.gov) or by calling 211.
