COVID Conversation What is NovaVax?

- On Tuesday, July 19th, CDC endorsed the Novavax COVID-19 vaccine. This is the fourth one to be authorized in the United States for the prevention of COVID-19 for adults ages 18 and older.
- Unlike the other vaccines, Novavax
 directly injects a version of the spike
 protein (the spikes you see sticking out of
 the coronavirus in pictures), along with
 another ingredient that also stimulates the
 immune system, into the body, leading to
 the production of antibodies and T-cells.
- The Novavax vaccine is a traditional one compared to the other vaccines. Its technology has been used before in vaccines to prevent such conditions as shingles, human papillomavirus, and DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis), among others.

- Providing tailored tools and resources to combat overdose and address underlying risk factors will ultimately help reduce health disparities and save lives.
- Overdose death rates for American Indian/Alaska Native women 25–44 years of age were nearly two times that of White women 25–44 years of age.
